What a year! With very little rainfall within the past year it has put a strain on all of us: You the consumer and the water system trying to keep up with the demand.

Many of you experienced low water pressure throughout the year due to the numerous water-main breaks and the construction for the Overhead Tank and Ground Storage Tank renovation. We hope to finish the 3 remaining well sites in the first quarter of 2006. To do this required renovation, it is necessary to drain the storage tanks to complete the construction. By doing so, this will put the well site out of commission for at least 3 weeks per site. The areas that will be affected are Northeast of I-35 & FM 455 and the area West of Krum. We are asking for your patience during this time, and if you experience really low pressure please call the office or the after hours emergency line and a service tech will call you back.

What to do in a Water Emergency??

Bolivar strives daily to prevent water outages for our customers. By regularly maintaining our lines and wells, we make great efforts to avoid the inconvenience of water service interruptions. However, problems do occasionally arise. Lines may break, or get hit by other companies working near our mains, and wells may malfunction. But Bolivar stands firm in our commitment to serve our customers around the clock.

After regular business hours, please call the office at 940-458-3931. When prompted to enter an extension, please enter 50. You will be connected to the emergency pager. Please speak slowly and clearly. Briefly explain your

problem, giving us your name, address and phone number. A technician will

return your call. In the event of multiple resident outages (for example: line break), technicians will be working diligently to solve the problem and may not be able to return all the calls immediately. Please be patient and know that we are working on the problem.
