NEW FEE NOTICE

In the Spring of 2009 the Groundwater Conservation District of Wise County was formed and this year the Denton, Collin and Cooke County GCD was formed. These districts have formed to keep track of the water being drawn from the aquifers used by all water providers. A fee is being accessed for every 1000 gallons pumped by Bolivar Water and surrounding providers. This fee will be pass through to the customers.

Example of fee: Your gallons used was 5,000 X .33 ÷ 1000 = \$1.65 added GCD tax fee.

We made it through another summer without going to a water rationing notice program. We are so thankful for the much needed rain.

This past year has been very costly due to the Canyon Lake Well going dry. This well was drilled in 1972. We were forced to drill another well to supply this area. The new well is finished and is pumping around 225-240 gallons per minute compared to the old at 80 gallons per minute. With a larger pump and the latest in technology, the new well should last 40-50 years with a little luck.

Thanks to all of the members/customers that were affected in this area for being so understanding and patient during this transition.
